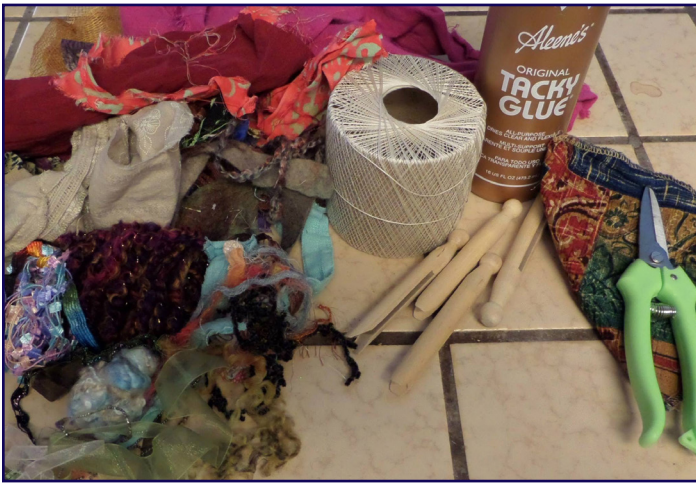


Awesomeart

Pocket or Worry Dolls by Griselda Tello

Items needed:



- Wooden clothespin or popsicle sticks
- Shoulder pads or terry cloth
- Cloth pieces, various sizes and designs
- String
- Yarn
- Doll Face
- Embellishments
- Ribbons
- Tacky Glue
- Scissors
- Sewing and Beading Needles

Step 1

Wrap the shoulder pad or small terry cloth piece around the wooden clothespin or popsicle stick.



Step 2

Securely wrap the worry doll body with string. Knot the ends to prevent slippage and cut off any excess.



Step 3

Glue the back of the doll face and secure to a small cloth and the doll's body. Wrap the cloth piece around the face like a head scarf.



Step 4

Wrap an additional piece of cloth around the face and body as desired to build your worry doll's character. Secure with decorative ribbon to embellish.



Step 5

Wrap with a coordinating or contrasting piece(s) of cloth around the doll body and head. Securely wrap with different ribbons or yarn as desired. Knot the end and cut off excess string or yarn.



Step 6

Add any decorative embellishments to your worry doll as she calls to you. It can be as simple or as complicated as you and your doll want.

Note: Ensure that the decorations are securely attached.
